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About the Venue

Colchester Arts Centre – the little church with a big attitude, deep in the heart of Essex.

Capacity

Seated performance (with full stage – most shows, music, comedy etc) – 220 Seated performance (with reduced stage – sold out comedy only mostly) – 240 Standing performance – 400

Theatre configuration with raked seating - 80

Cabaret and custom seating with tables available on request.

Parking

There is no parking at the venue, other than three disabled parking spots. The nearest parking is a multi-storey car park called St. Marys, height restriction 1.97m. We offer discounted tickets at £1.50 per vehicle, please contact box office.

Loading Access

Outside the venue there is a loading bay, this leads step free into the venue through double doors (about 3 metres from loading bay to venue). There are then ramps, if required, up onto stage. Front of house position is on the floor level. There is a doorbell to gain access. W3W for loading door: spun.most.loudly.

Tour Buses

Tour buses can park in the loading bay directly outside the venue, with prior agreement. We are currently able to provide 16amp power and 32amp single phase power for tour buses. Due to the age of the area the venue is in the road leading to the venue is very narrow and requires an experienced driver, however it is possible for tour buses to get down. Tour buses with trailers and artic lorries get down regularly.











Facilities

- There is one dressing room space with tea and coffee making facilities, artist only fridge, microwave/oven, mirror and chairs, there is an optional second space available if more room is required.
- There is **Wi-Fi** available throughout the venue, see signage backstage for name and password.
- There is an accessible backstage bathroom with shower facilities, towels available on request.
- o There are women's and gender-neutral **toilets** front of house.

Merchandise

We can provide a merchandise area/table on request with lighting. We **do not** take commission for merchandise.

Accessibility

The Colchester Arts Centre is mostly step free. Steps located in the below areas:

- Three steps up into the box office, there is a sturdy handrail in place here.
- Three steps up onto stage from stage right, this to also access the backstage area. There is no handrail here. Ramp available.
- Five steps up to the green room/kitchen from the main bar, there is a sturdy handrail from here. Another route is available with three steps, or a ramp is available.
- Five steps up onto stage from downstage left. Another route is available with two steps, or a ramp is available.

All other areas including audience entrance into the space and front of house to the side of stage area are step free from pavement outside.

Disabled Parking

There are three disabled parking spots on Church Street, directly outside the venue.

Facilities

There are two accessible toilets on site. One backstage, with fully accessible shower/wet room and accessible toilet. The other accessible toilet is front of house towards the audience entrance.

Assisted Listening

The Arts Centre uses an infrared assisted listening unit, connected to the main sound system, with infrared outputs covering both standard and theatre layouts of the venue.

Health and Safety

Please ensure **risk assessments** for your performance are sent prior to your visit, if you need help doing this please get in touch.

Fire exits are located either side of the auditorium, one towards the front of the auditorium and the other towards the back of the auditorium. There are also two other exits, the main performance entrance and the box office entrance. The assembly point is the far corner of the graveyard (between Colchester Arts Centre and Quaker House) for all staff, visitors and customers.

For the safety of performers, staff and the audience, all **hot FX and pyrotechnics** must be discussed and have written consent from the Technical and Production manager prior to use and come with risk assessments.


The Firearms Act 1968 demands that all **replica and prop weapons** for use in productions/shows be controlled with strict rules and regulations. Therefore, any replica or prop weapons (no matter how fake they look) must be discussed prior to use in a performance and have its own risk assessment, this includes prop gun confetti cannons. It is illegal to have a replica/prop weapon in a public space without authorisation from the local police.

Smoking and the use of e-cigarettes/vaping is prohibited indoors.

Layout


2D of Main Space (for most shows – Music and Comedy shows)



Stage from Audience




Stage from FOH Position

Stage - Standard Layout (most shows - music and comedy shows)

The venue's standard set up is black box, on a stage with a removeable front (reduced stage). This set up is used for gigs and standard shows. Capacity being up to 400 (see capacity section).

Dimensions for Standard Stage

4600mm x 7900mm - Full stage


4600mm x 4500mm - Reduced stage (sold out comedy only usually)

Access for Standard Stage

There are three ways to access the stage. Steps downstage left, from the green room upstage left and via some steps upstage right. Alternatively, a ramp is available upstage right for disabled access.

Side of Standard Stage

Due to the nature of the building, with the standard set up on the stage (not theatre) there is no traditional wing space. Only a side of stage upstage right.

Tabs/curtains for Standard Stage

There are house tabs, controlled via pulley system that come in from each side of downstage. There is then another set mid-stage that can be used to half the stage size or as house tabs when using a ripped stage. At the rear of the stage, there is another set of tabs on a pulley system used as the back of the black box set up, these are also controlled via pulley system.

<u>Stage – Theatre Style Layout (Wonderful Wednesday/Small Theatre)</u>

The venue can also be used in reverse, in a more traditional theatre style set up with a <u>smaller raked</u> <u>capacity, up to 80</u> (see capacity section). This set up is generally used for our Wonderful Wednesday performances but can be requested for other shows.

Dimensions for Theatre Style Stage



Access for Theatre Style Stage

The theatre style stage in on the ground floor as there is access all around through the black curtains.

Side of Theatre Style Stage

Behind the back of the theatre style stage is the main audience entrance for the performance and access to the main toilets. Stage right is also accessed by the audience, as this will be area for the bar. Stage left is not used by audience members but does have a fire exit so will need to be clear within two metres of these doors.

Tabs and Curtains for Theatre Style Stage

There are black curtains making up a black box set up around the pillars with plenty of slits to make entrances for performers. These curtains do not have pulley system and will need to be manually moved around. There is a static black backdrop on LX6 that is not on a curtain track. The static backdrop can be moved downstage to LX5 and LX4.

Sound

The sound system is made up of a four-way, powerful, flat response, point source array with complimenting subs on either side of stage, along with front fills and side fills for full coverage of the venue. For more details see bottom of 'Sound' section.

The sound level restriction is 100dB at FOH position and the sound curfew is 23:00.

Detailed Description

The PA system comprises of a four-way, powerful flat response, flown, point source array, complimented by matching bass reflex subs and controlled by MC2 DSP enabled amplification. This system is matched with a redundant Dante Architecture allowing for a full digital signal chain from console to PA system. Front and side fills are included to allow full coverage in a standard 'Left, Right, Sub, Fill' configuration.

We can accommodate touring consoles and provide analogue (four XLRs in L, R, Sub and Fill configuration).

Lighting

The lighting system is a mix of generic and intelligent fixtures configured over **six universes** over ArtNet. Made up of profiles, washes and moving washes and spots, providing a dynamic range of scenes and FX to fit any show. The lighting is a fixed rig and can only be changed with prior arrangement with the Technical and Production Manager.
