
We have two choices of layout styles, Classic Wonderful Wednesday or Alternative Wonderful Wednesday, see below. Please choose one and let the technical team know.

Raked audience with performance area on flat wooden flooring, surrounded by pillars with black box cloths.

- Flexible lighting rig
- Full coverage PA system
- 6M by 6M performing area
- Behind audience tech position
- Capacity of 80
- Earliest get in of 10.30AM






Alternative Wonderful Wednesday:

Gig like style, on raised stage with optional seating of rows of chairs or cabaret style seating with tables and chairs.

- Fixed lighting rig, consisting of moving washes, moving spots, LED parcans, battens, generic wash and blinders, added optional ground package. All running over 5 universes
- Full coverage PA system
- 4.6M by 7.9M performing space
- Behind audience tech position
- Capacity of 220, but with flexible seating options to accommodate lower sales
- Earliest get in of 9AM





Technical Riders

Before your visit to us, our technical team will be in touch to request your technical rider and any other riders you may have such as your catering rider or access rider.

See below a list of information examples we will be looking for, you could have all or only some of these, anything you can send us in advance will be helpful.

- Script of your performance or running order.
- Stage layout.
- Stage requirements, such as chairs or tables or any set that you will be bringing.
- Lighting plan.
- Lighting requirements.
- Sound requirements.
- AV requirements such as projection.
- Any show files such as Qlab, MagicQ, ETC, Show Cue System etc.
- Show personnel, are you bringing an operator, tour manager, how many performers etc.
- Any hangings or rigging you will need to add to our rig. Our load weight is very, very low, so please get in touch asap if you have anything weighty you need to hang.

Any of/all the above will help for a smooth get in, tech and get out of your performance and help our team in the planning process immensely.

Alternative Wonderful Wednesday Layout -

This is a fixed rig, consisting of moving washes/spots, LED parcans, generic specials, generic wash, LED battens and blinders. An optional ground package is also available.

Our in-house desk for this is a ChamSys MQ70, our staff are trained in programming this desk is you need to relight or reprogramme your show file.

This set up runs over 6 universes.

We have limited decking available as well as standard tables and chairs.

Typical Schedule of the Day

Depending on your choice of layout of the venue will determine your earliest get in, for the Classic Wonderful Wednesday layout, the earliest you can get in is 10.30AM, as this will allow us time to build the raked seating, for the Alternative Wonderful Wednesday layout, the earliest you can get in is 9AM as we will not have to reset the space before your arrival.

How the Show Starts

For our Wonderful Wednesday performances, Anthony Roberts (the director of Colchester Arts Centre) does a speech to welcome the audience and explain the Pay What You Can Afford ticket pricing and how the evening will work, this can be done either within the show seating or within our bar area, this is up to you on the evening, whatever works best for the show.

Accessibility

Colchester Arts Centre is a mostly step free venue. Steps located in the below areas:

- Three steps up into the box office, there is a sturdy handrail in place here.
- Three steps up onto the stage/audience seating area from stage right, this to also access the backstage area. There is no handrail here. Ramp available.
- Five steps up to the green room/kitchen from the main bar, there is a sturdy handrail from here. Another route is available with three steps, or a ramp is available.
- Five steps up onto stage/audience seating area from downstage left. Another route is available with two steps, or a ramp is available.

All other areas including audience entrance into the space and front of house to the side of stage area are step free from pavement outside.

Disabled Parking

There are three disabled parking spots on Church Street, directly outside the venue.

Facilities

There are two accessible toilets on site. One backstage, with fully accessible shower/wet room and accessible toilet. The other accessible toilet is front of house towards the audience entrance.

Assisted Listening

The Arts Centre uses an infrared assisted listening unit, connected to the main sound system, with infrared outputs covering both Wonderful Wednesday set ups.
